Request an early postal vote

To apply for an early postal vote, contact the Election Manager from Wednesday 9 February 2022 on 03 8619 1498 and make an application. You must provide a valid reason.

How to nominate as a candidate

To nominate as a candidate, you must:

- be an Australian citizen and enrolled on the voters' roll for Maroondah City Council AND
- be eligible to become a councillor should you be elected AND
- have completed the mandatory candidate training before lodging your nomination with the Election Manager.


