c. We will plan new ways to share facts about enrolling and voting when a person does not have a home.




d. If it is safe we will go to places people access services and they can vote there.




### 2. Working together in the community

b. We will make sure the words we use to talk about people who do not have a home are up to date.




c. We will write a guide for our staff to use when they want to share news about people who do not have a home.

a. We will ask 6 people who know about prison to meet twice a year to help us.




b. We will make sure that our prison projects are up to date.


