

# Registered political party membership requirement – Statutory declaration

## Instructions for completing a statutory declaration

When making the statutory declaration the declarant must say aloud:

*"I, [full name of person making declaration] of [address], declare that the contents of this statutory declaration are true and correct."*

## Statutory declaration

At least 500 members of the political party are Victorian electors and members in accordance with the rules of the political party, and not members of another registered political party in Victoria or a political party applying for registration in Victoria.

**I declare that the contents of this statutory declaration are true and correct, and I make it knowing that making a statutory declaration that I know to be untrue is an offence.**

<sup>1</sup> Under section 3 of the Electoral Act, **secretary**, in relation to a political party, means the person who holds the office (however described) the duties of which involve responsibility for the carrying out of the administration, and for the conduct of the correspondence, of the party.
