

Financial year annual return

Declaration of no obligation – Third-party campaigner

The registered agent of a third-party campaigner must submit a financial year annual return to the Victorian Electoral Commission by **20 October** each year.

You are a third-party campaigner if you are an individual or organisation that receives political donations or incurs political expenditure equal to or above the general cap in a financial year and you are not one of:

- a registered political party (RPP)
- a candidate at an election, a group of candidates, or an elected member, or
- an associated entity.

The 2025-26 Financial Year covers the period 15 April to 30 June 2026. The general cap for the 2025-26 financial year was \$5,030.

If you were previously a third-party campaigner but did not meet the relevant threshold for the 2025-26 financial year, please submit the declaration below.

Definitions of political donations, political expenditure and third-party campaigners are provided in section 206(1) of the *Electoral Act 2002*.
