3. Will fall in line with most councils of our size in Victoria

Having multi-councillor wards, I feel, will have the following benefits:

1. Reduce the occurrence of needing redistribution
2. The resulting larger wards would more likely be aligned along whole suburbs instead of part suburbs as is now the case.
