I am writing to you today because I am concerned that a review of the current Electoral Boundaries in Boroondara is proposed.

It has been my experience in Hawthorn since I arrived in 1985 that the system works well. Sure there have been changes to the Ward Boundaries,

and at one stage our area was moved from the Studley Ward to the Glenferrie Ward, but the reason for the change was clear. I have only had to communicate with one Councillor the whole time, before the amalgamation in 1994 and since that change.

I don't like the idea of having to communicate with more than one Councillor in my ward.

**We have 10 Wards in Boroondara and one Councillor per ward I would like it to stay that way.** It is so clear with whom I have to contact to discuss an issue in a particular Ward in Boroondara. It would not be if there was more than one representative in a Ward increased in size.
